

Lakota Five-Hole NAF Fingerings

based on Nakai Tablature for Native American Flute

developed by Clint Goss

The chart displays the following notes and their corresponding fingerings:

- Root:** C4 (one hole closed)
- Minor Third:** Eb4 (two holes closed)
- Fourth:** E4 (three holes closed)
- Fifth:** F4 (four holes closed)
- Seventh:** G4 (four holes closed)
- Octave:** C5 (all five holes closed)
- Minor Tenth:** Eb5 (all five holes closed)

Notes:

- Fingerings for Lakota tuned flutes - Chris 't Coom by Larry Spieler, White Raven Flutes by Kai Mayberger, etc..
- Fingerings for notes above the octave note may vary among individual flutes.
- Notes above the Minor Tenth may not resonate on a particular flute.
